



Feasts Appointed days of celebration and worship

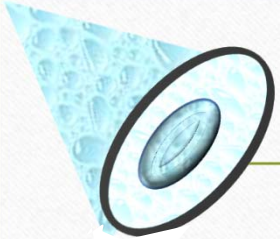
Meaning Typologies / Shadows pointing to Jesus' role in our redemption (Colossians 2:16-17)

Purpose: Believe in Jesus, the Messiah (John 5:39, 1 Cor 15:3-4)



Overview of Redemption Story

Feast	Event to remember	Key feature	Looks forward to	Meaning
Passover	Passover	14 th day of 1 st month (Passover lamb)	Death	We are (will be) spared
Unleavened Bread	Passover to Red Sea	15 th to 22 nd day of 1 st month (No yeast)	Burial	We are (will be) delivered
First Fruits	Arrival in promised land	Start of Harvest (sheaf of first grain)	Resurrection	We are (will be) raised
Weeks	Inauguration of Old Covenant at Sinai	End of harvest (50 days after start)	Pentecost	We are (will be) filled
Trumpets	Sinai (most likely)	1 st day, 7 th month (trumpet blasts)	Great Commission / End times	We are (will be) ready
Atonement	Ministry of priests in earthly sanctuary	10 th day 7 th month (fast)	Jesus' blood / Tribulation	We are (will be) reconciled
Tabernacles	Living in booths	15 th to 21 st day of 7 th month (booths)	Kingdom of God / Eternity	We are (will be) in the Lord presence
